# HOW TO USE TEMPLATE SHEET

Use a template sheet to mark the position of the embroidery design on the fabric. For viewing and printing the template designs or the template reference chart, **Acrobat® Reader** software is required.

#### **Opening Template Designs**

Download template data into your PC.

Open the **Template reference chart** to find the category and file name of the desired embroidery design.

Open the folder of the category.

Open the template sheet of the desired embroidery design.

## **Printing Template Sheet**

## • Page size

When printing a template sheet, be sure to select **Actual Size** in the print settings under **Page Sizing & Handling**.

#### Orientation

Select **Portrait** in the print settings under **Orientation** when printing. Print out the template sheet.

# How to use Template Sheet

- Cut the template sheet according to the size of the design and place it on the fabric where you would like to embroider. Mark 4 dots at the end of Direction of arrow the positioning lines with a marker as shown.
  - \* A water-erasable marker works best.
- 2. Draw positioning lines connecting the dots and also draw an arrow, as illustrated.
- 3. Set the fabric in the embroidery hoop, matching the positioning lines on the fabric with the positioning lines of the embroidery hoop template.
- \* For setting the fabric in the embroidery hoop, see your machine's instruction manual.
