

## Instructions for Installing EmbroideryEditor

Computer System/Device Requirements:

- \* OS: Windows 11 (64 bit) or Windows 10 (32 or 64 bit)
- \* CPU: 800 MHz minimum (1 GHz recommended)
- \* Memory: 512 MB minimum (1 GB recommended)
- \* Hard Drive: 80 MB minimum free space
- \* Video Resolution: 800 x 600 minimum (1024 x 768 recommended)
- \* USB cable and port

This process installs the following software:

1. EmbroideryEditor
2. USB Driver Installer (Jsmc864Installer)


- \* The following installation example uses a Windows 11 OS.
- \* You need to log in as [Administrator].
- \* For instructions for EmbroideryEditor, see [Help].

## Installing EmbroideryEditor


1. Start up your PC and close all other applications before beginning installation.
2. Download the file from the website and save it on your PC.  
The three digit number XXX after “EmbroideryEditor” indicates the version of the file you downloaded.




3. Double click on the downloaded file.
4. “EmbroideryEditor - InstallShield Wizard” starts up automatically.  
Click [Install] to start installation.  
If the following dialog box is not displayed, go to step 6.




5. “User Account Control” dialog box opens. Click [Yes].




6. The following dialog box opens. Click [Yes].  
If the following dialog box is not displayed, go to step 7.




7. “EmbroideryEditor - InstallShield Wizard” starts up automatically. Click [Next].



8. The end-user license agreement (EULA) appears.  
Read the EULA and check “I accept the terms in the license agreement” if you agree. Click [Next].  
If the following dialog box is not displayed, go to step 13.



9. Enter a user name and click [Next].



\* For tablet PCs, enter a user name with the touch keyboard (see the following instructions).


9-1. Tap the text box.

9-2. Tap the touch keyboard icon in the desktop taskbar to open the touch keyboard.


9-3. You can enter a user name using the touch keyboard.



10. Click [Next] if you accept EmbroideryEditor installation location.




11. Select your sewing machine and check it. Click [Next]. You can reselect the model at any time.




\* Actual model names can be different from the above picture.

12. Click [Install] to start the installation.




13. "User Account Control" dialog box opens. Click [Yes].

\* Installation will take 1 – 2 minutes, depending on the specifications of your PC.



14. When EmbroideryEditor is successfully installed, check "Launch the USB driver installer" to install. Click [Finish] to exit.



\* If the installation of EmbroideryEditor is completed without checking "Launch the USB driver installer", please refer to "Installing the USB Driver after the Installation of EmbroideryEditor" on page 3 for installing the USB driver.

15. EmbroideryEditor icon appears on your desktop.




16. Delete the downloaded "EmbroideryEditorXXX.exe" file.


## Preinstalling the USB Driver

Install the USB driver to transfer embroidery designs from PC to the sewing machine using the USB cable.


17. After EmbroideryEditor has been installed, “User Account Control” dialog box opens. Click [Yes].




18. “Driver Package Installer” opens. Click [Next].



19. “Windows Security” opens. Click [Install].



20. When the USB Driver Installation is successfully preinstalled, click [Finish].



21. When connecting your PC to your Sewing machine for the first time, USB Driver is installed automatically.  
\* Refer to the instruction book of the sewing machine for how to connect PC and the sewing machine.

## Installing the USB Driver after the Installation of EmbroideryEditor

Windows 11:


1. Click  on the bottom left corner of the screen to display the start screen.
2. Click [All apps] to show the App view.
3. Click the  icon on the right side of EmbroideryEditor folder. EmbroideryEditor group is displayed in Apps view. Click [Jsmc864Installer].



4. Please follow the procedure 17 – 21 on page 3.

Windows 10:

1. Click  on the bottom left corner of the screen and select [All apps].
2. Click [EmbroideryEditor] folder to display EmbroideryEditor group. Click [Jsmc864Installer].
